SIMONE SUBAL This Lower East Side gallerist's booth is given over to paintings, drawings and a single yellow breast, made of enamel and fiberglass and hanging from a nail, by the Austrian artist [Kiki Kogelnik](#), who died in 1997. Ms. Kogelnik's paintings feature bright colors, figures and simple geometric shapes, under which she compressed enormous emotional and formal complexity. In the 1972 painting "Express," a barefoot female figure with blown-out cheeks and a sex-doll mouth is an incandescent vision of anger and control.
